For those that are collecting lateral flow tests for the adults to do at home, we have been advised that they can no longer be collected from Rochdale Leisure Centre. This has resorted back to a PCT test Centre.

Where are the local PCR test centres and when are they open?

Our main local test centres are located at:

- Rochdale In the car park at Rochdale Leisure Centre, Entwisle Road, Rochdale OL16 2HZ. <u>Find Rochdale Leisure Centre on Google maps</u>. Open 8am-8pm every day.
- Middleton in the marquee on the Market Place Car Park next to Middleton Arena, Old Hall Street,
 Middleton M24 1AG. Find the Middleton test centre on Google maps ©. Open 8am-12noon every day.

You must drive, walk or cycle to the site - do not use a taxi or public transport. If this is not possible, you'll need to order yourself a home test.
