Qualifying benefits for free school meals

To get free school meals for your child you or your partner must get one of the following qualifying benefits:

- Income Support, income-based Jobseekers Allowance or income-related Employment Support Allowance;
- The Guarantee element of State Pension Credit;
- Child Tax Credit - but **not** Working Tax Credit or work over 16 hours per week and your total annual household income must be low enough - we can tell you more about this;
- Working Tax Credit during the four-week period immediately after your employment finished or after you start to work less than 16 hours per week; or
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999.

You and your partner must also get Child Benefit for your child and live in the Rochdale Borough.

If you no longer get any of these qualifying benefits, you must tell us straightaway.

Proof of your qualifying benefit

You no longer need to provide proof of your qualifying benefit with this form, as we'll check entitlement via a secure government website.

16 - 18 years old and still at school

You can claim free school meals as long as you get Income Support, income-based Job Seekers Allowance or income-related Employment Support Allowance.

New starters

If your child is due to start school for the first time, please fill in a new entrant form a few weeks before they start school. These are available from the school or you can contact us, our details are at the end of this page.

Claiming a refund, if you've paid for meals we later award you

If we award free school meals for a period of time that you've already paid for, and want a refund you must contact the school direct.

Other financial help for pupils aged 16 - 19

Other help is available for pupils aged 16-19 in full-time education, from the Local Education Authority.
