Welcome Back

<u>Class One</u>

Class one children need to have welly boots in school so that the children can take part in 'Welly Walk Wednesdays'.

PE Kits and Uniform

The children have all looked very smart this week in their school uniforms. Please ensure that names are written clearly on each item of clothing used for school including on P.E. Kits. All children need to have a P.E. kit for school that includes a plain white t-shirt, plain navy, grey or black shorts in addition to plain, navy, black or grey jogging bottoms and sweatshirt for outdoor use. A pair of trainers and pumps is also needed by all children.

Homework

We have adopted a new school homework policy – which is printed in the back of the homework/reading diary that was given to all children this week. There is also a weekly homework plan which is year group based in the back of the diary. All children from years 1 -6 will start 'Spellzoo' this week. Golden Time for homework begins next week. From Tuesday 20th September there will be a homework club open to all children that will run until 3.45pm. A letter will go out shortly.

<u>Dogs</u>

Please be aware that dogs are not allowed on the playground. As much as I personally and most of the staff love dogs – the playground is not the right place for them. This is for health and safety reasons.

Snacks at Break time

We have a healthy eating policy at school and we encourage our children to have healthy snacks at break times. We support the Government initiatives and follow Rochdale Policy on what is allowed at break times. A list can be found on the website and there are notices around school as to what is considered to be an appropriate snack for school. All reception, year 1 and year 2 children are entitled to fruit at break time which we provide.

Parking

Mrs Lumb would like to say thank you to those parents who have been parking their cars away from the school building. This allows her to see the oncoming traffic clearly and ensure that the children get across the round safely. Please do not park near the school building on Huddersfield Road as it makes Mrs. Lumb's job very difficult to do. In addition, Church Lane needs to kept clear of cars as this is our entrance into school. Cars and children do not mix well!

Dinner Money

Dinner money is now £2.05 per dayk. The total cost for this term is: £71.75. Dinner money must be paid on Mondays. We will not allow areas of more than two weeks – this is in line with the Charging and Remittance policy. Failure to pay for school dinners will result in children not receiving a school dinner.
