Lexia and Times tables Rockstars



Children who find reading and spelling difficult have been given access to **Lexia**. This is an online programme to support children in learning to read and write. Research shows that children who use this programme regularly make on average an **additional two months progress** compared to those that don't access the programme. This progress is crucial in closing the gap for those that struggle. If your child has a Lexia account, please support them at home by accessing the programme for 10 minutes a day.

All children have a login for Numbots and **Times Tables Rockstars**. These are online games that support in the development of the recall of number facts. All children in **year 4** have to complete **a times table check** set by the Government in June. Children are expected to answer the times table questions in 6 seconds using an online programme. Times tables Rockstars is the perfect tool to support with this. The children who do best with this are those that use Numbots and Times tables Rockstars little and often.
